Financial counsellors

Financial counsellors work in community organisations providing free, confidential, independent and non-conflicted services for people under financial stress and hardship. They can:

- suggest ways to improve your financial situation
- talk to creditors about repayment arrangements
- explain the risks of bankruptcy and debt agreements and talk through the alternatives
- refer to other services, such as a gambling helpline, family support or Legal Aid.
