KARI LEADERSHIP PROGRAM BOOSTED BY icare NSW

Twelve emerging Aboriginal leaders from NSW participated in the first two days of the 2018 KARI Leadership Program, hosted by <u>icare NSW</u>.

The <u>KARI Leadership Program</u>, facilitated by KARI, an Indigenous social support service based in Liverpool, assists Aboriginal leaders from many industries and backgrounds to achieve personal or professional goals.

Steve Ella, former rugby league footballer and graduate from the KARI Leadership Program, spoke to the participants about what it means to him to be a leader in the indigenous community.

"Growing up Aboriginal, you don't see yourself as a leader – your aunties and uncles are leaders. It was only when I retired from rugby league that I realised I was perceived as a leader," Ella said.

"The KARI leadership course allowed me to question my leadership style and explore my strengths and weaknesses so that I could better understand and support my team."
