Proof of Identity Fact Sheet

Do I need to prove my identity?

To help us protect your privacy and your entitlements we will ask you for to provide us with copies of documents that prove your identity and the identity of each of dependant that you have listed in your application.

What documents will I need to provide?

You will need to provide a copy of your current Medicare card. You can also provide a copy of your current pension concession card if you have one.

We will also ask you to provide one or more documents showing your name, age and current address and documents for each of your dependants also showing their names, ages and current addresses. Below is a list of suggested documents that you can provide:

- A current Australian driver's license or learner's permit or State issued photo card.
- A birth and/or marriage certificate
- A current passport
- Bills such as your telephone, electricity or gas bill if they are less than six months old
- Bank statements, showing your residential address, if less than six months old
- A council rates notice that is less than 12 months old
- Your residential tenancy agreement
- Nursing home or residential aged care facility agreement
- Statements or other documents issued by Centrelink or the Department of Veteran Affairs
- Australian citizenship certificate
- A current fire arms license
- Current motor vehicle registration papers
- Current travel concession for secondary school student
- Current student card

For full time students over the age of 16 years but aged under 21 years, we will need a letter from their school, college or university confirming their enrolment.

We ask that you provide us with clear photo copies of your documents and that you do not send us original documents.
